Treasurer's report	<ul> <li>TB CIRCULATED IN ADVANCE A REPORT TO COMMITTEE.</li> <li>ML gave a brief overview of budget position that all line items are on track with no significant shortfalls.</li> <li>However there is a potential risk that we will fall short of our Sponsorship and Grant budget of £10K by the end of March. We swam faster at this meet than ever before, achieving many new National Qualifying times and District times, some massive PB's.</li> <li>High number of GCSC swimmers now swimming sub 60 for 100 free, probably more than in many years at the club.</li> <li>Sophie Hall gained QT for Commonwealth Trails in 800m.</li> <li>DSE short course Nationals also produced some outstanding results for Disability.</li> </ul>
